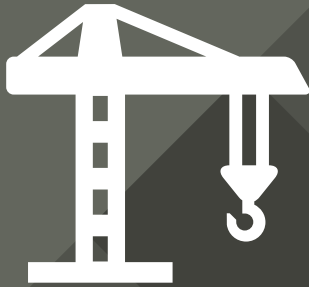
Course overview

On average, 39 construction workers are killed each year as a result of accidents. With a high proportion of workplace accidents taking place within the construction industry it is more important than ever to have a good understanding of the policies and procedures that will promote health and safety and aim to reduce this number.
